## What is the WorldEthicForum?

The WorldEthicForum is, in the first place, an emerging ecology for a worldview of interconnectedness and interbeing as a proposition to other existing pathways.

It is a platform and container to inquire collectively into the question of: “How do we come to a new responsibility and life-affirming relationship with ourselves, each other, and the natural world?”

The next seven years are designed as a transdisciplinary process to deepen relationships across perceived divides, cultivate practices and build individual and shared capacities, explore potential leverage points, and enable small and larger actions.

The yearly forum – with inspirational inputs, experiential workshops, and transdisciplinary and artistic performances – brings together local and global actors who seek to cultivate and nurture a culture rooted in an embodied and radically shared aliveness.

These in-person gatherings are nourished throughout the year with public events, thematic working groups, an active firekeeper circle, and participatory action research.

## Why do we do what we do?

The stake is high, the unfolding challenges are daunting, and the past and current strategies and solutions don't seem to add up to the highly needed shift in mindset and actions. What if we first have to actually acknowledge what led us to these global polycrises? What if the ingredients of meaningful solutions are equally to be found in HOW we embody and approach our doing? What if it's more about a cultural inversion than linear and technological innovations?

The WorldEthicForum sees itself as an invitation to tackle the current issues and societal challenges by exploring the roots of the core issues and perpetuating dynamics together. From this in-depth understanding, it envisions having more aligned clarity on leverage points and meaningful actions. Hence, supportive practices and collective capacities will be essential to help transcendence and co-shape a cultural soil that enables well-being for all forms of life.



## What's the intention?

Through its multi-layered approach, it wants to contribute to a meaningful societal transformation towards inclusion, co-creativity, and the well-being of all. A society characterized by a radically shared aliveness, maintaining the conditions for an embodied culture of care and partnership.

It acknowledges that there are many yet unknown factors and that this work is complex and everyone is a learner. Hence it gets approached iteratively, inspired by a system and interspecies perspective.

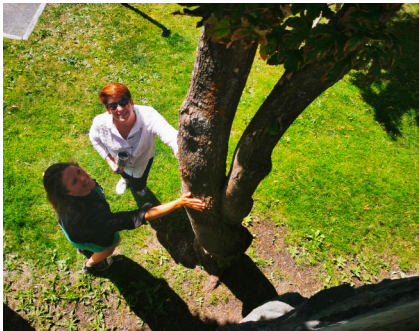


## Who is part of it?
